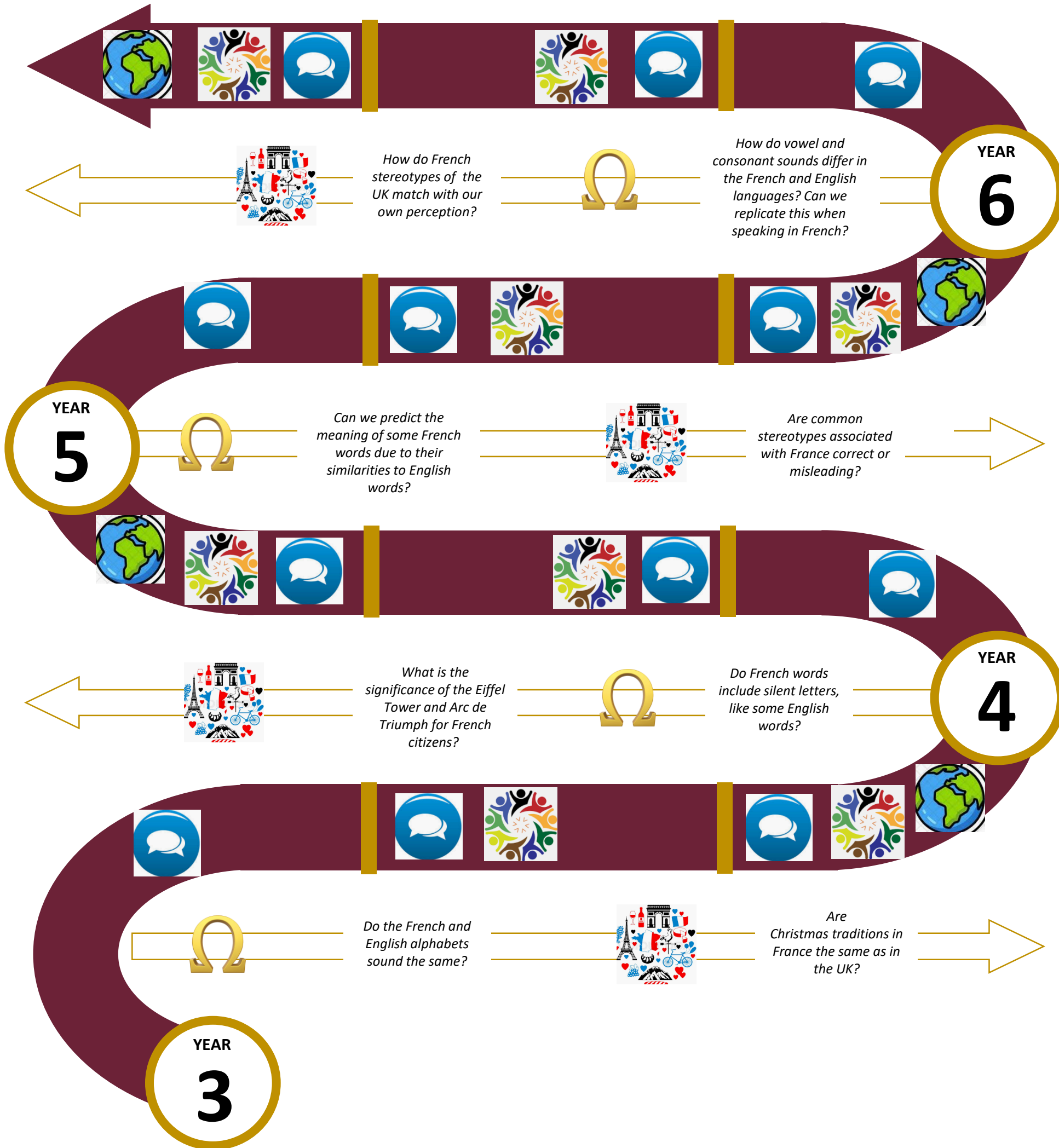




# French:

## French Core Concepts



**Communication**  
Expression of ideas and thoughts using language and to understand and respond to other speakers



**Culture**  
The ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular people or society



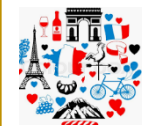
**Geography**  
Exploring key geographical features of France including landmarks and rivers

**Language**  
Explore the French language by comparing it to English, in terms of pronunciation, spelling and origins.



**Tradition**  
Explore French traditions and customs.

## Outcomes

### Year 3

- ✓ Understand simple classroom phrases and commands
- ✓ Name six common classroom items
- ✓ Count from 0-30 in French

### Year 4

- ✓ Be able to use three main greeting questions and answers to hold a simple conversation in French
- ✓ Know the months of the year
- ✓ Name and locate on a map 10 French cities

### Year 5

- ✓ Count from 30-60 in French
- ✓ Tell the time (o'clock) in French
- ✓ Name 15 animals in French

### Year 6

- ✓ Count from 60-100 in French
- ✓ Use a bilingual dictionary effectively
- ✓ Use French phonetic knowledge to read unfamiliar words

Year 1 – Knowledge lesson – greetings (hello and goodbye) in French.

Year 2 – Knowledge lesson – counting 0-10 in French.
