

# Art Knowledge Organiser: Sketching

## Key Vocabulary: Texture

**Stippling-** the art or process of drawing, painting, or engraving using numerous small dots or specks

**Scumbling-** modify a drawing with light shading in pencil or charcoal to give a softer effect

**Continuous line-** a drawing where it is unbroken from the beginning to the end

**Contour line-** drawing using lines to show the outline of a form, as well as interior structure, without the use of shading

**Perspective-** the representation of three-dimensional objects or spaces in two-dimensional artworks

**Vanishing point-** the place where parallel lines viewed in perspective art appear to meet at a point

**Portrait-** a painting, drawing, photograph, or engraving of a person, especially one depicting only the face or head and shoulders

**Hatching-** shading with closely drawn parallel lines.

**Cross hatching-** shade an area with intersecting sets of parallel lines.

Different mark making techniques can give different tonal and texture variations.
